Emergency evacuation routes, Slow Streets, Transit Oriented Communities, TDM, congestion pricing, sustainability, bike and pedestrian safety, regional organization reports Metro long range plan/recovery, Bus turnaround at Gladstone's, completion of Braude Bike path to separate pedestrians and bikes, PCH intersection improvements at Temescal/West Channel/Chautauqua, Complete streets, parking, slow speed lanes, active transportation safety, post-COVID recovery strategies related to climate change and pollution, broadband to allow work from home, VMT reduction, San Vicente walkability, first mile/last mile solutions from Metro stations, transportation between the Valley and the Westside.
