BCC MOTION TO SUPPORT WRAC MOTION re: SB15 *Passed April 14, 2021*

The BCC supports the Westside Regional Alliance of Councils (WRAC) recognition of the need for positive solutions to the state's affordable housing crisis, specifically as it relates to workforce and low-to-moderate income housing. Solutions should involve legislation that does the following:

1. focuses on increasing the production and supply of truly affordable housing;
2. does not compromise public safety or the environment; and
3. respects principles of democracy, local land use control and self-determination of local governments to expand housing opportunities unique to their jurisdictions.

The BCC supports the WRAC motion to support Senate Bill 15 (Portantino) which seeks to provide incentives for cities to convert unused big box stores into workforce affordable housing.
