Suggestions for topics for future meetings – from October 2021:

- 1) *Invite Metro and have them talk about their active transportation program and their tree program;*
- 2) *Discuss trees as it relates to making active transportation more appealing to pedestrians and providing shade at transit stops;*
- 3) *Discuss using trees to offset the carbon footprint and pollution from transportation (i.e. mitigation measures for global warming);*
