- **6.1.2.Review WRAC LUPC Guidelines** Discussion and possible action regarding an addition (in blue) to Guideline #3 which reads:

Each WRAC-member Council may designate one (1) Representative and one (1) Alternate member to serve on the LUPC, however only one (1) vote may be cast by each Council for each agenda item. All Representatives and Alternates present at a meeting shall be permitted to participate in the discussion of every agenda item considered by the LUPC. Any WRAC-member Council that has not been represented by a voting member for at least one LUPC meeting per quarter will be removed from quorum count. - Motion withdrawn due to offers by members to assist in meeting quorum. - 6.2.1.[Ross] Template for NC's WRAC Members' Use Regarding Housing Element Discussion and possible action for an NC a WRAC Members' template to the Department of City Planning requesting halting of the Housing element's proposed upzoning until a detailed justification, based on Dwelling Unit Capacity, is presented. Original motion moved by Laferriere, seconded by Longcore. Motion to add "Template" at top, moved by Julie Ross, seconded by Sann, approved without objection. Amended motion approved without objection.
- 6.2.2.[Ross] Template for NC's WRAC Members' Use Proposed Revisions to LAMC/Zoning Discussion and possible action for an NC a WRAC Members' template to the Department of City Planning regarding the Westside Transit Neighborhood Plans and TOC/Density Bonus ordinances. Will have "Template" at top. Original motion moved by Jay Ross, seconded by Julie Ross. Motion to add "Direct to NC's or CC's City Council member to introduce a motion for a new ordinance." Amendment moved by Sann, seconded by Jay Ross, approved without objection. Amended motion approved 8 to 1 (Bhagat), 1 abstention (Lanet), abstentions do not count in vote tally.
