- b. 22.31. Support for Letter re Mistreatment of Animals at City Animal Shelters** – August 15, 2022 (passage deadline January 2023; formally adopted by WRAC December 2022); 10 councils adopted: BABCNC, BCC, DRNC, MVCC, NCWP, PalmsNC,\* SORONC, WLASNC,\* WNC, WWNC.
