Re: **CF 20-1536-S4 – Request for Audit by the City Controller and CAO of STAP Revenues and Expenditures**

Honorable City officials:

The Westside Regional Alliance of Councils (WRAC) is a coalition of all fourteen neighborhood and community councils on the Westside of Los Angeles, located in CDs 5 and 11 and portions of CDs 4 and 10.

WRAC's member Councils have long expressed concern about transparency, preservation of community character, environmental impacts and public safety related to the STAP process. See prior WRAC position letter submitted in CF 22-1154: [https://westsidecouncils.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/02/WRAC-STAP-2\\_4.pdf](https://westsidecouncils.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/02/WRAC-STAP-2_4.pdf).

Now, WRAC's member Councils are concerned about the STAP "rollout" and about serious questions that have been raised regarding the program's management and the revenues and costs associated with STAP.<sup>1</sup> As a result, more than a majority of WRAC member councils (9 councils) have adopted the following motion, which is an adopted position of WRAC:

*"The \_\_\_\_\_ CC/NC, a member of the Westside Regional Alliance of Councils, is concerned about the current status and management of the STAP program under the new contractor Tranzito-Vector and requests an audit of the program by the City Controller and Chief Administration Officer's (CAO) office of the revenues and expenditures for this new STAP program."*

The language of the above motion has been approved by the following WRAC member councils: Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council, Brentwood Community Council, Del Rey Neighborhood Council, Mar Vista Community Council, Neighborhood Council Westchester-Playa, Pacific Palisades Community Council, Westside Neighborhood Council, Westwood Community Council and Westwood Neighborhood Council.

No member councils have opposed the WRAC motion or submitted a minority letter to accompany this position.
