

**Background Information: Motion by DRNC and VNC  
and recommended by the WRAC HOC –  
Support for CF 23-0914/Park (regulation of oversized vehicle dwelling)**

Proposed Motion:

\_\_\_\_\_ NC/CC supports CF 23-0914, which calls for recommendations for a citywide program to designate streets where RVs/oversize vehicles can safely park with access to services, including housing navigation, portable restrooms, automotive repair and septic tank disposal, and would also restrict RV parking in residential areas, commercial corridors and other sensitive areas.

Background/justification:

Increased oversized vehicle (RV) dwelling has negatively impacted communities throughout the Westside of Los Angeles and as such is a regional issue. WRAC Member Council neighborhoods and other neighborhoods throughout the City have been impacted by increased RV parking with lack of support services, which can in some cases result in illegal discharge of hazardous substances into storm drains and public rights-of-way, loss of parking for non-vehicle dwellers, reduced line-of-sight at intersections and driveways and other impacts.

CF 23-0914 (Park) calls for a report back on regulation of such activity, including restrictions on RV dwelling in residential areas, commercial corridors, and sensitive uses. Del Rey NC and Venice NC have submitted CIS in support, and the WRAC Homelessness Committee (HOC) also recommends support for this Council File.
