

**Background Information: Motion re CF 25-0006-S38 (report back on creation of a “Climate Resiliency District” for areas impacted by the recent wildfires)**

Council File approved 2/6/25 by the Ad Hoc Committee for LA Recovery and transmitted to the Budget & Finance Committee for consideration (pending).

On 2/5/25, Palms NC voted to submit a CIS in support of the Council File and specifically efforts to address shortcomings in water infrastructure procedures (wording above). Palms NC now brings this motion to the WRAC board for recommendation to WRAC member councils.

Note (from C. Spitz): Since the catastrophic fire occurred on January 7, the directly impacted community council, Pacific Palisades CC (PPCC), has not been able to hold a regular business meeting but instead has held a series of special meetings with relevant officials to provide the community with information necessary to begin the recovery process. PPCC will begin business meetings in February and is likely to take up this Council File in due course.
